

together at the Cowboy Poetry Gathering in Nevada. The film accompanies them as they record their unique way of life in poems and songs and consider their place is in today's world. It shows their rough and ready everyday life as well as their creative work and combines this with breathtaking nature shots to create a piece of nostalgic "Americana."

ONE WITH THE WHALE

An Indigenous story of resistance.

Hunting whales is a matter of life or death for the residents of St. Lawrence, a tiny island in the Bering Sea. So, when Chris Agra Apassingok becomes the youngest person to ever harpoon a whale for his Alaskan village, his mother proudly shares the news on Facebook. To her surprise,

thousands of keyboard activists brutally attack. One With the Whale chronicles the obstacles Chris and his family face, amidst larger currents of food security, environmental justice, climate change, cultural genocide, and social media. The livelihood of the Apassingoks and their village are threatened as they search for a balance between modernity and a traditional subsistence lifestyle.

What can we do to help the whales?

COLLISION presents how a worldwide increase in shipping traffic is threatening our oceans, its inhabitants and the planet. It focuses on the under-reported issue of fatal ship strikes on whales, a threat which is endangering their very existence.

The film not only highlights the issues but also presents clear and available solutions to encourage governments, authorities and global shipping companies to make vital changes.

The Ocean Souls Films team partnered with leading scientists, NGO's and worldwide authorities, ensuring an



accurate and scientifically based account of the realities of the harsh impact of marine traffic on ocean life.

Since the first film, Food Inc. (2008 Oscar-nominated and Emmy-winning documentary) multinational corporations have tightened their stronghold on the US government. The system at large has robbed workers of a fair living wage, and profit-focused corporations are proliferating a

chemically formulated international health crisis by focusing on growing the market for ultra-processed foods. Food Inc. 2 centres around innovative farmers, future-thinking food producers, workers' rights activists and prominent legislators such as US Senators Cory Booker and Jon Tester, who are facing these companies head-on to inspire change and build a healthier, more sustainable future.


Wilding

Based on Isabella Tree's best-selling book by the same title, Wilding tells the story of a young couple that bets on nature for the future of their failing, four-hundred-year-old estate. The young couple battles entrenched tradition, and dares to place the fate of their farm in the hands of nature. Ripping down the fences, they set the land back to the wild and entrust its recovery to a motley mix of animals both tame and wild. It is the beginning of a grand experiment that will become one of the most significant rewilding experiments in Europe.





first salmon to return home each year, they have always been a sacrament for the oldest civilizations in North America and the keystone of Northwest ecosystems. Once occupying the most extensive range of any salmon species in the United States, many genetically unique populations of spring chinook have already been lost. Those that remain face a looming risk of extinction as habitat loss, short-sighted fisheries management, and climate change continue to take a toll on their numbers.

In The Lost Salmon, filmmaker Shane Anderson set out on a two-year journey across Washington, Oregon, California, and Idaho to document some of the last wild "springers", the historical and ongoing causes of their declining numbers, and their profound relationship to the people and places of the Pacific Northwest. approximately 8,000 Crow (Apsáalooke) tribal members who live there.

The Crow Tribe—like most tribes—have been reliant on federal, tribal and non-profit food distribution centres. As a result, tribal nations across the country are exploring the idea of 'food sovereignty,' the inherent right of a community to identify its own food systems. Returning to traditional and nutritious foods has been shown to be an effective way to restore Native food systems and create employment. However, restrictions on ancestral hunting grounds are preventing tribal members from providing for themselves and their families.



Up until as late as 1979, very little, if any, moving image created in or about the Outer Hebrides was made from anything other than an outsiders' perspective. This lack of an indigenous viewpoint led, at best, to an uninformed, and often romanticised, representation of island life.

In 2021 the Scott collection of



Berneray footage from the 60s and 70s was digitised and featured in the award-winning feature documentary Dùthchas produced by UistFilm. Since then we have been inundated with new collections donated by local people inspired by the realisation that these 8mm 'home movies' have a great cultural value.



Whale Watching with Janet Marshall

Tuesday 1st October

Wednesday 2nd October

10am – 2pm Port of Ness

Tiumpan Head, east of Stornoway, and Berie just northeast of Port of Ness are two of the best places in Europe to see the widest range of whales and dolphins from land. The water gets very deep very quickly at both locations so the big beasts are sometimes so close in that they can be seen as well as heard.

Well known local wildlife observer Janet Marshall will be at Tiumpan Head on Tuesday 1st October, and at Port of Ness on Wednesday 2nd October 10:00 – 14:00 and will help point out any wildlife, describe the botany and associated folklore. Janet has seen 18 different varieties of whale and dolphin from these shores, and helped co-ordinate the response to the mass stranding of Pilot Whales on



Lewis last year. On a clear day we have spectacular views of the mainland, and also from Tiumpan we can see to Skye.

This event is weather dependent, if it is wild and wet the creatures may well be there, it is just that we can't see them through the annoying, pointy, fin-shaped waves. If there is poor visibility only creatures that come really close in can be seen. An alternative date may be given, watch out for details.

Please park carefully, at Tiumpan either near the lighthouse, avoiding blocking access, or a little further back

along the road in a parking area. At Port of Ness there is parking above the harbour then head north east. Wear suitable footwear, there is a gravel path at Tiumpan but at Port of Ness you walk over grassland that can be wet. Use sunscreen as the sun reflecting on the sea can give you a double dose of UV. The wind can be chilly so be prepared with some warm garments – however it can also get pretty warm so make sure that you stay hydrated.

Janet has several pairs of binoculars that you may borrow, but bring your own if you have them.





PG – Parental Guidance

General viewing, but some scenes may be unsuitable for young children. A PG film should not unsettle a child around eight or older. Unaccompanied children of any age may watch, but parents are advised to consider whether the content may upset younger, or more sensitive, children.



12A

Films classified 12A contain material that is not generally suitable for children aged under 12. No one younger than 12 may see a 12A film in a cinema unless accompanied by an adult. Adults planning to take a child under 12 to view a 12A film should consider whether the film is suitable for that child. Suitable only for 15 years and over, no one younger than 15 may see a 15 film in a cinema. No one younger than 15 may rent or buy a 15 rated video work. Films may contain strong language, violence or short scenes of a sexual nature.



18

Suitable only for adults. No one younger than 18 may see 18-rated content in a cinema. No one younger than 18 may rent or buy an 18-rated video.
